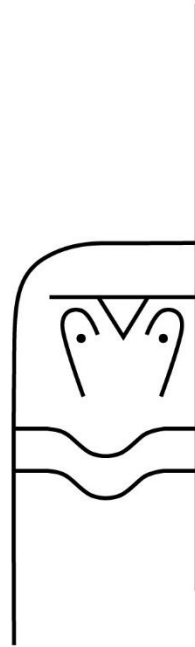
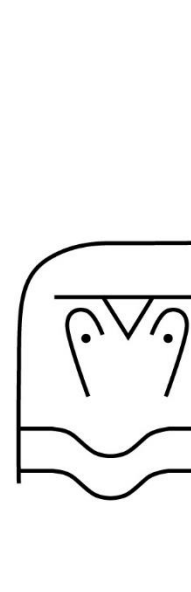

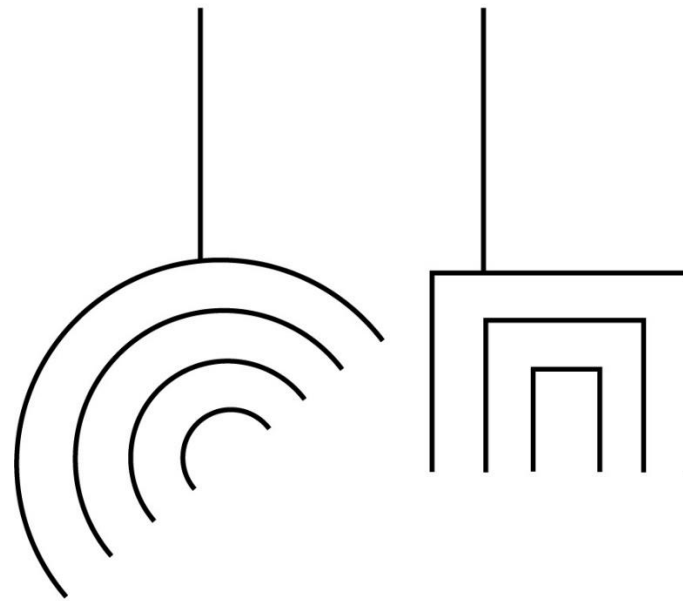
Face of the head.

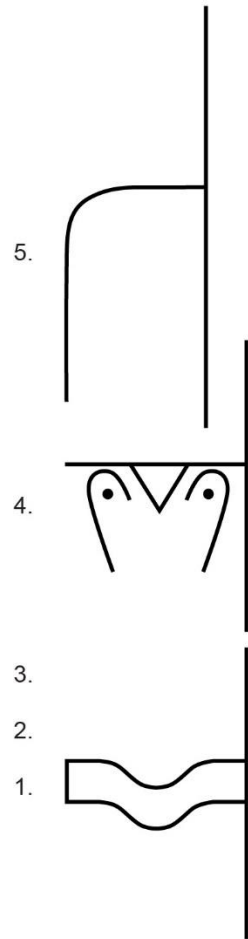

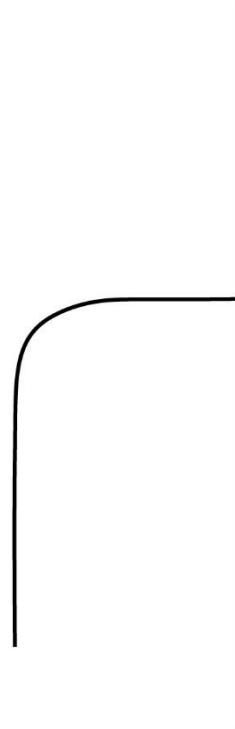

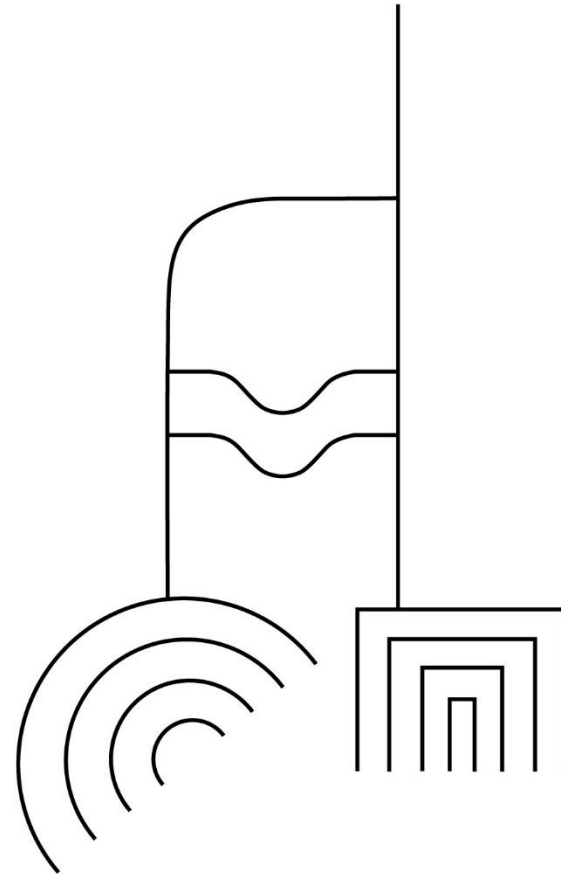

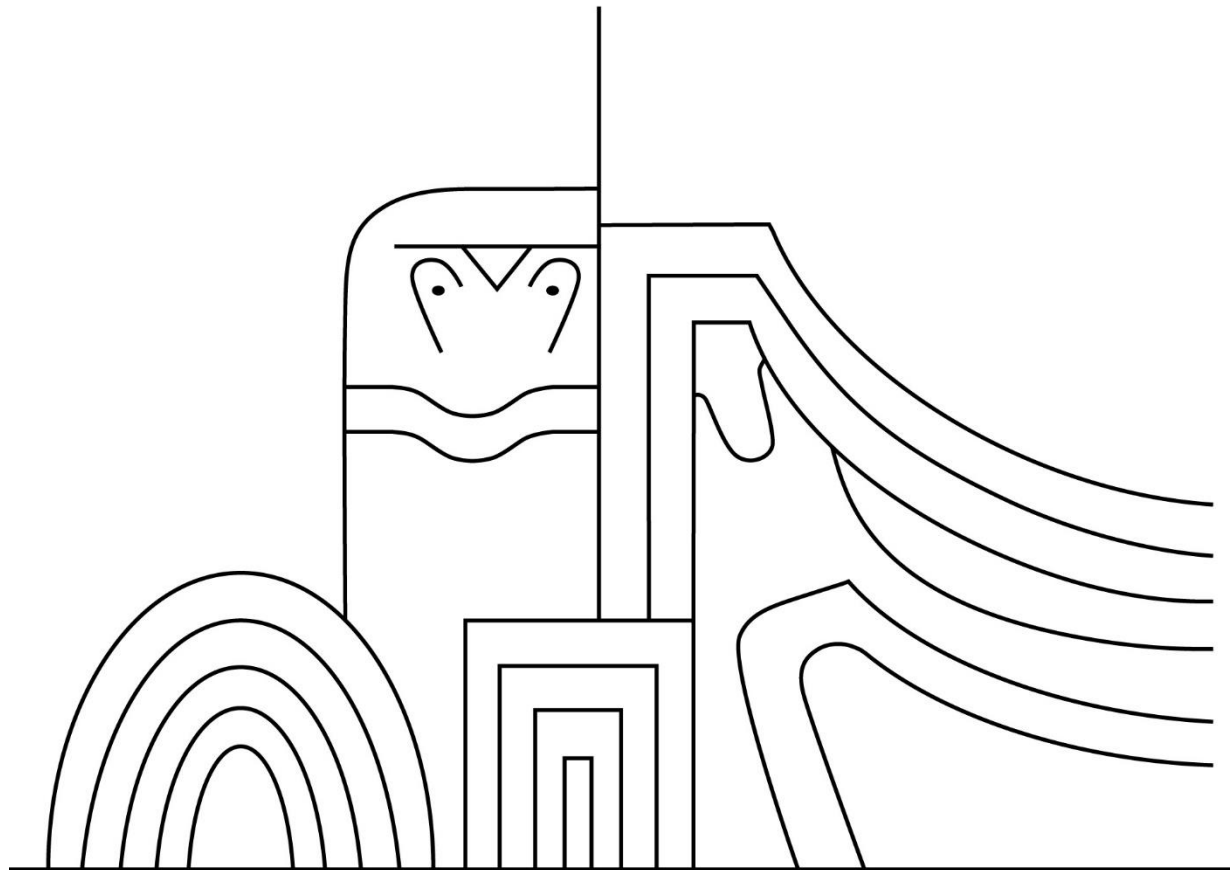
